### Thailand (Bangkok) Fresh Human Cadaver Dissection Training

In November 2017, we held a specialized dissection study program with fresh human cadavers at the University of Hawaii, School of Medicine. The program went so successfully that we have decided to hold the 2nd session this year.

Trunk area is added to the study this year. The participants will be divided into several groups according to their preferences based on the questionnaire collected preliminarily. We will be taking photos and videos in some parts of the program this year. Even better environment is going to be created this year.

During the previous session, we conducted a comprehensive and widely range of training from basic dissection to general surgery focusing on the face. The following is some of the comments from the participants.

This year, we will also introduce the lectures on breast augmentation techniques and surgical demonstrations with the dedication of the trunk.

In addition, we have prepared a **Tour Course** for young doctors who might think "I want to learn a lot of things, including the basic study of operation, however, I am wondering if it's too early for me to have a dissection practice." and for doctors mainly specializing in dermatology and cosmetic dermatology. (For participation, a recommendation by your guidance physician is required. If you have a permission from your present lecturer, a demonstration like injection is available.)

The location is Asia this year, so there is no need to worry about suffering from jet lag, and the price is lower than previous session in Hawaii. It is very easy to participate.

Thailand has good climate and many tourist attractions. There will be enough opportunities to communicate with teachers who usually attend academic conferences.

Please join us on this occasion.

Note: The cadavers used in the practice are donated to the university for medical purposes. We have a consensus with the university regarding this as a major prerequisite for practical training. I would like to ask the attending doctors to fully understand this point and proceed with the practical training. Please think "I would like to thank the bereaved family for agreeing with the will of the person who donated his or her body for medicine, and I would like to study sincerely." ### 1. Facial Training Course (This is a course where you mainly practice facial dissection.)

2. Trunk Training Course (This is a course where you mainly practice trunk part such as breast enlargement.)

(Regarding above two courses, you can observe and practice another course freely provided that the trainees' consensus. Also, the donated cadavers used by the professor can be practiced freely after the operation demonstration.)

# 3. Tour course (for those who want to see the basic dissection of the face and trunk and those who mainly provide injection services)

(Participation in the tour course requires the recommendation of a trainee or instructor of (1) or (2). With the permission, you can practice injection, for example.)
